Frequently Asked Questions

What is defined as Gross earnings?

Gross earnings is defined as any income for the calendar year including: salary, wages, commissions, fees, etc., received for personal services rendered and income derived from self-employment. EXCLUDED from the definition are the following: social security benefits, workers' compensation payments, inheritance, retirement benefits, income earned from rental property, stocks, bonds, IRAs and interest earned on deposits.

What are earnings limitations?

Limits Before Attaining Service Retirement Age:

Section 13-171 of the Administrative Code provides that a disability retiree may receive income from employment in the private sector or the public sector if they have not yet met the age requirements (service requirements for plans allowing retirement without regard to age) under their retirement plan.

The amount a retiree may earn is the difference between the maximum current salary of the next higher title from that which they retired, and the maximum pension portion of their retirement allowance.

Limits After Attaining Service Retirement Age:

Once a disability retiree attains the minimum age requirement (service requirement for plans allowing retirement without regard to age) for their retirement plan, Section 1117 of the NYC Charter governs earnings limitations for post-retirement public employment. Section 1117 provides that a retiree's pension must be suspended if their total pension and earned income from the City, State or a municipality within New York State exceeds \$1,800 in any year. NYC Transit retirees are not subject to this limitation.

Income from Public Benefit Corporations or the private sector is exempt from the \$1,800 limitation in the NYC Charter.

What happens if I don't file this affidavit?

If NYCERS does not have this form on file, your pension will be suspended until a completed, correct form is received.

What if I make a mistake?

If this affidavit contains errors or is incomplete your pension will be suspended until a completed, correct form is received.
