NYCERS seeks to hire a Director of Information Technology, who will oversee the daily operations of the IT Division including the Brooklyn and LIC Data Centers, Information Security, and Project Management Office. NYCERS is facing a time of significant change, which stems largely from targeted legacy replacement projects and the adoption of cloud technology. The candidate will be responsible for maturing IT practices in all facets of the SDLC process as well as Enterprise Architecture with the goal of achieving the mode of continuous delivery and ease of integration while leading IT through changes in the IT landscape. The candidate will devise the IT Strategy and Technology Roadmap in a manner that supports the achievement of enterprise goals and business objectives and ensures the operability of critical Systems. The ideal candidate will collaborate with and support the business and administrative units in the implementation of new technology, applying a best of breed approach and/or modification of existing Systems to meet the growing needs of the organization. The candidate will foster a culture that promotes the upskilling of the IT staff, agility in adapting to change, and places a high degree of value on service to the business and in maintaining a reliable, dependable, and scalable IT infrastructure. The candidate may also perform related duties at the request of the Executive Director.

The ideal candidate will have prior experience in overseeing the IT budget and expenditures (including budgeting and forecasting), presenting information to senior staff including Board members, strategic project planning and execution of project goals, leading and inspiring technical teams to deliver exceptional results, and the continuous improvement of IT processes and performance including in areas of IT Automation.

This position requires confidence, independent action, initiative, a sense of urgency, and the ability to make decisions and take responsibility for them. A well-suited candidate can react and adjust quickly to changing conditions and come up with practical solutions for dealing with them in collaboration with stakeholders. There is a great deal of challenge and pressure, and people and problems must be handled with confidence and collaboration. The position requires self-discipline, self-assurance and drive, while applying equal value on effectively working with and through others to build consensus.

3. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent approved by a State's department of education or recognized accrediting organization and six years of experience as described in "1" above; or
4. A satisfactory combination of education and experience equivalent to "1", "2" or "3" above. However, all candidates must have at least a four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent approved by a State's department of education or recognized accrediting organization and must possess at least three years of experience as described in "1" above, including the 18 months of administrative, managerial, executive or supervisory experience as described in "1" above.
